HEALTH CORNER

- **The COVID Vaccine is NOW AVAILABLE for everyone 5 years of age and over, when your child is vaccinated, please provide a copy of their vaccination card to the front office.**
- Please note you are not considered fully vaccinated if you are eligible for the booster and have not yet received it.
- Keep your students home when they exhibit symptoms associated with COVID, such as headache, fever, cough, stomach ache, runny nose, etc.
- According to the CDC quarantine from a positive case can be reduced to 5 days ONLY if you have experienced NO SYMPTOMS. If you have a positive result and ANY symptoms you must quarantine for a minimum of 10 days.
- **It is imperative you report when a household member has tested positive for COVID-19 or is displaying symptoms.**

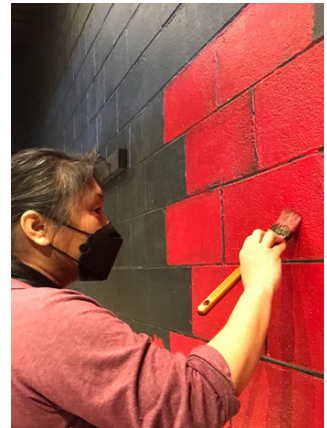
