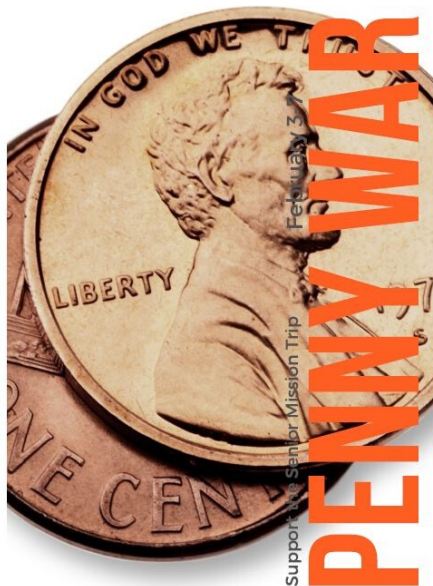
## 100th Day of School
