HEALTH CORNER

- Free weekly COVID PCR testing is available to all parents and students who are interested.
- With cold and flu season just around the corner, please make sure your children are eating healthy foods, drinking plenty of water, and getting enough sleep.
- Please send your child with a **mask from home that fits**, as this helps prevent transmission of respiratory droplets from reaching others. We have limited supplies for emergency use.
- Keep your students home when they exhibit symptoms associated with COVID, such as headache, fever, cough, stomach ache, runny nose, etc.
- It is imperative to report when a household member has tested positive for COVID-19 or is displaying symptoms.
- If you child have received their COVID-19 vaccination, please provide a copy of the vaccination card for their medical file.
- According to the IL Department of Health "Schools shall Exclude any Student or School Personnel who exhibit symptoms of COVID-19, as defined by the CDC, until they test negative for COVID-19 or for a minimum of 10 days, until they are fever free for 24 hours and until 48 hours after diarrhea or vomiting have ceased."
- In order to return to school after you have experience ANY Covid symptoms you must provide a negative PCR test.




